The Merced Irrigation District is seeking qualified applicants for Hydroelectric Project Manager. The Project Manager plans, directs, and administers the operation and maintenance activities of the project facilities; provides highly technical and responsible staff assistance; and does related work as required. Responsible for ensuring the project is operated and maintained in compliance with all applicable local, state and federal regulations and laws as well as the 1964 Power Purchase Contract with PG&E. Minimum Qualifications include BA degree from an accredited college or university, unless exceptionally qualified by relevant experience, professional engineer preferred. A min. of 10 yrs exp. in hydroelectric operations and maintenance with at least 3 yrs exp. as a manager of a substantial hydroelectric facility. Possession of an appropriate CA Driver's License. Live in District provided housing located at the Hydro Project.

Merced ID owns/operates the Merced River Hydroelectric Project located on the Merced River in Mariposa County, California. The project includes two developments - Exchequer and McSwain – each of which include one reservoir (Lake McClure and McSwain Reservoir) and one powerhouse (New Exchequer and McSwain powerhouses) generating 103 megawatts.
