



## **Relicensing of the Merced River Hydroelectric Project**

### **SECOND PUBLIC MEETING**

The Merced Irrigation District owns and operates the Merced River Hydroelectric Project located on the Merced River in Mariposa County. The Project is composed of Lake McClure, New Exchequer Dam and Powerhouse, McSwain Reservoir, and McSwain Dam & Powerhouse. The current Federal Energy Regulatory Commission license for the Project expires on February 28, 2014. The District intends to apply for a new license no later than February 28, 2012.

To assist in the development of its application, the District held a Public Meeting in Merced, CA on July 23, 2008, with members of the public and Federal/State resource agencies attending. A list of preliminary issues was developed by the group.

The relicensing participants elected to schedule a second public meeting to review the preliminary issues developed and to allow those who are interested in the Merced River Hydroelectric Project Relicensing and could not attend the July 23 meeting to participate in issue development.
