The Merced Irrigation District is seeking qualified applicants for Assistant General Manager (AGM) of Business Development and Electric Resources. This individual provides leadership for the general direction and supervision of marketing, customer service, and resource planning within the District's Energy Resources Dept. Responsibilities include resource planning, wholesale power negotiations and agreements, and representation of Merced ID in CPUC hearings; develop and implement strategies for competition and growth; meet with large industrial and commercial customers and the public; supervise personnel in the areas of business development, customer account management, public benefits, energy efficiency, customer service, and financial analysis; attend Board meetings and make regular presentations to the District's Board of Directors.

Merced Irrigation District is a complex public agency with over 175 employees providing agricultural irrigation water to over 125,000 acres, operating a hydroelectric dam and lake system for irrigation, generation, and recreation, and providing electric services to over 7,000 customers.

Qualifying criteria include a Bachelors degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, business admin., economics, marketing, or related field or equiv. exp. A minimum of 6 yrs of increasing responsibility and experience in an electric utility, with a minimum of 3 yrs in a management role.

Must possess the knowledge of electrical transmission and distribution, electrical rates, energy management and efficiency strategies; industrial processes, corporate economics, and competitive threats; contract preparation and administration; pertinent federal, state and local laws and regulations; and proficient in the use of computers and related software applications. Ability to understand electric industry power purchase principles and utilize strategies to insure District electric customers experience competitive rates. Must maintain a current knowledge of electric utility techniques and practices.

Salary for this position is DOQ. The Merced ID is a public agency and an EOE, AA employer with a wide range of benefit programs along with participation in California Public Employees Retirement program.
