Merced Irrigation District is inviting children between the ages of 6 and 12 to submit their best artwork for the Annual MID Water and Canal Safety Poster Contest. The contest is intended to promote awareness about the dangers of playing in and around open canals and other waterways.

The five top winners will receive a season pass to the Island Water Park in Fresno. Ten runner-up winners will receive overnight camping passes to Lakes McClure and McSwain. The winners will additionally have their posters displayed in the MID lobby.

Posters must be no larger than 11 by 17 inches and pertain to water and canal safety. All submissions are due to MID's office by 3 p.m. on Monday, June 3. MID is located at 744 W. 20 St. in Merced. The winners will be announced on Tuesday, June 4.
