Surplus Property Sale

The Merced Irrigation District (MID) has declared numerous pieces of equipment and materials as surplus property, available to be purchased by members of the public.

Sealed Bid Auction and Public Viewing

To facilitate the purchase and sale of MID's surplus property, MID will hold a sealed bid auction. In order to be considered, all bids must be made on the sealed bid form provided by MID, and submitted in a sealed envelope with the title "MID Surplus Property Sale – Sealed Bid" clearly marked on the front of the envelope. Bid forms and rules are available at the MID Main Office, the MID Franklin Yard Equipment Repair Shop and on our website at www.mercedid.org.

Sealed bids must be received by 3:00 pm on Friday, April 12th at MID's Main Office, located at 744 W. 20th Street, Merced. The surplus equipment/material may be viewed at the MID Franklin Yard, located at 3321 N. Franklin Road, Merced. Viewing times will be from 9:00 am to 11:00 am, and from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm starting on Wednesday, April 10, 2019 and ending on Friday, April 12, 2019. The sealed bids will be opened on Tuesday, April 16, 2019.

Conditions of Sale

- All sales are "as-is, where-is". It is the Bidders responsibility to personally view the items upon which he/she bids and assure themselves as to its condition. MID makes no warranty, either expressed or implied as to the condition of the equipment being sold, its merchantability or its fitness for any particular use. Bidders may bid on one item, multiple items or all items. Each piece of surplus property will be awarded to the highest bidder, however **the Merced Irrigation District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, at its sole discretion.**
- When operated in California, any off-road diesel vehicle may be subject to the California Air Resources Board In-Use Off-Road Diesel Vehicle Regulation. It therefore could be subject to retrofit or accelerated turnover requirements to reduce emissions of air pollutants. - An on road heavy-duty diesel or alternative-diesel vehicle operated in California may be subject to the California Air Resources Board Regulation to reduce particulate matter and criteria pollutant emissions from In-Use Heavy-Duty Diesel Vehicles. It therefore could be subject to exhaust retrofit or accelerated turnover requirement to reduce emissions of air pollutants. For

- The Buyer shall be responsible for payment of any applicable sales or transfer taxes, registration of the vehicle and any certification required for those processes. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code 24007.5, notice is given that all buyers of vehicles must obtain a certificate of compliance for smog control devices prior to registration. Purchases shall be responsible for all such certifications. The document certifies the vehicle complies with applicable Health and Safety Code requirements.
- Equipment will be released to the successful bidder upon receiving payment in cash, certified cashier's check or money order made payable to the Merced Irrigation District. Personal or business checks will not be accepted. Payments can be made at MID's Main Office 744 W. 20th St., Merced. All sales are final, refunds or adjustments will not be made.

Pick-up times are from 8:00 am to 11:00 am and from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm Monday through Friday. Equipment must be picked up within ten (10) days after the bid opening.
