

REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

regarding proposed updates to Merced Irrigation District's Agricultural Water Management Plan
(Notice previously published on June 18, 2021)

The Board of Directors for the Merced Irrigation District (MID) will hold a public hearing on
Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at 10:00 AM

to consider adopting updates to its Agricultural Water Management Plan (AWMP).
Information on how to attend the public hearing may be found below.

Agricultural water agencies in California are required to adopt or update an AWMP every five years. MID previously adopted an AWMP and to meet requirements, MID is considering revisions to its existing AWMP. The AWMP includes a discussion of MID's water resources and demands, water conveyance facilities, as well as a variety of other programs, policies and efficient water management practices. The MID Board of Directors will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on the proposed revisions to its AWMP, prior to its consideration of adopting the revisions.
