



Invitation For Bid

MID IFB 2018-13 CAMPUS PARKWAY EXTENSION

Notice is hereby given that the Merced Irrigation District (MID) is calling for bids for contractor services.

1. The following shall be supplied on the attached Bid Proposal Documents.
 - a. Lump-sum bid to provide services
2. Evaluation criteria: Each bid will be evaluated based on the following criteria:
 - a. Competitive costing
 - b. Ability to provide the service
 - c. Availability to begin work
 - d. Ability to complete project by deadline of **Sunday April 28, 2019**.
 - e. Registered with DIR

Note: Merced Irrigation District reserves the right to select any proposal that in its sole determination best meets the requirements of the District, regardless of bid price, or to reject any and all proposals. Bidders will be notified if additional information from them is requested, if they were not successful, and if they were chosen for one or more sections of the proposed scope of work, if more than one section exists.

3. The bid amount shall include the furnishing of all materials, labor, supervision, equipment, supplies, transportation, fees, permits (other than the Encroachment Permits), and all other items necessary to perform the work and services requested.
4. Bid Proposal documents (one copy) must be received in a sealed envelope clearly labeled with "**MID IFB 2018-13 CAMPUS PARKWAY EXTENSION**" and the name of the Bidder printed on the outside of the envelope. Bids received unsealed or unlabeled will not be considered. Bids submitted by facsimile (fax) transmission will not be considered. Any bids received after the bid submittal deadline specified below will not be considered.
5. Bids will be received by the Reception Desk at the MID office located at 744 West 20th Street, Merced, California 95340. To be considered, bids must be received by the MID Receptionist no later than **Tuesday December 11, 2018 at 2:00 PM** (Local Time).

6. On or about **Friday December 14, 2018** the project will be awarded to the bidder who most meets the requirements set forth in the General Scope of Work, project drawings, and IFB.
7. A **mandatory** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on **Tuesday November 27, 2018 at 10:00 AM** at the MID office followed by a walk through at the project site. Please have a representative of your company present at the Pre-Bid Meeting if you wish to submit a bid. Contractors not attending the Pre-Bid Meeting/On-site Walkthrough **will not be considered** for the project. The address for the Pre-Bid Meeting is:

I. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Winning bidder shall provide proof of, or otherwise comply with, the following prior to commencement of work:

1. Liability insurance as follows (primary and sub-contractors):
 - a. \$2,000,000 each occurrence
 - b. \$5,000,000 aggregate
 - c. \$2,000,000 auto ea. accident
 - d. Merced Irrigation District as "Additional Insured"
2. Workers Compensation Insurance
 - a. 1,000,000
3. The required policy(s), noted above, shall be endorsed to provide the District with thirty (30) calendar days prior written notice of cancellation. Additionally, the policies shall also be endorsed by the insurance company (not the agent) to modify the policies to include Merced Irrigation District, its officers, agents, and employees as additional insured. The District is not liable for the payment of premiums or assessments on the policy.
4. This **will** be considered a prevailing wage project under the current State of California Prevailing Wage Determinations and applies to all job classifications.
 - a. Certified payroll reports **will** be required unless otherwise specified by the District.
5. Execution of Merced Irrigation District's standard Independent Contractor Agreement (MICA) and Non-disclosure Agreement (NDA)
6. Valid General Engineering Contractor's License A. Sub-contractors shall have the appropriate and valid license for their specialties, as well as insurance as specified above.
7. Bid bond equal to 10% of the bid amount to be included within sealed bid.
8. Performance and Payment bonds equal to 100% of the bid amount to be provided to the District prior to commencement of work.

- Bids will be due on **Tuesday December 11, 2018 at 2:00 PM Local Time at MID Main Office**
- Estimated contract award date is **Friday December 14, 2018.**
- Completion date is **Sunday April 28, 2019.**

Oral instructions may, however, be given by Merced Irrigation District upon inquiry by a bidder to direct the bidder's attention to the location in the specifications or Invitation For Bid that cover the subject of the inquiry.
