MERCED IRRIGATION DISTRICT

ELECTRIC SERVICE SCHEDULE RES-2 RESIDENTIAL GENERAL SERVICE

APPLICABILITY:

This schedule is offered to single-phase and poly-phase residential service in single-family dwellings and apartments separately metered by Merced Irrigation District; to single-phase and poly-phase service in common areas in a multifamily complex; and to all single-phase and poly-phase farm service on the premises operated by the person whose residence is supplied through the same meter.

TERRITORY SERVED:

The entire area within the Merced Irrigation District service boundary as distribution lines and capacity are developed and declared available by the District.

MONTHLY RATES:

The greater of the following Customer or Energy Charges which are effective on the date of meter reading for each account.

Mandated Charges (PBP & Local Government Permits & Fees do not exceed 5.35%)

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum charge for each month or portion thereof shall be the Customer Charge.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. For customers changing schedules between billing dates, the schedule in effect at the time of the end of the normal billing period will be used to compute the bill.
- 2. For customers who qualify for the additional Standard Medical Baseline Quantity under the criteria in Electric Service Rule 20, an additional 500 kWh of electricity will be added to the customer's regular Baseline Quantity. All usage exceeding the combined Baseline Quantities shall be billed at the Tier 2 rate.
- 3. Low income (CARE) discount rates for this schedule must meet the criteria in Electric Service Rule 20.1. The CARE discount is equal to a 20% reduction on the energy charge on Tier 1 and Tier 2 usage. All usage exceeding Tier 2 shall be billed at the discounted Tier 2 rate.
- 4. Where service is supplied through new electric facilities provided by the District, the electric service supplied shall be in accordance with a contract authorized by the District's Board of Directors.
- 5. Any customer who reapplies for service within 12 months of canceling that same service must pay, before the new service will be provided, the total Customer Charges that would have otherwise been payable between the prior cancellation date and the new service date.
- 6. No Customer Charge, Minimum Charge, Energy Charge, (Demand Charge, Power Factor Charge) or any other Charge shall be payable if the Customer ceases to have any electric service requirements at the location designated in the Customer's Agreement to Provide Electric Services.
- 7. Mandated Charges: Public Benefits Program (PBP) is mandated by the State of California to provide services to low-income customers and to promote energy conservation and renewable energy sources. This fee is set at the existing rate of the Investor Owned Utilities, presently at 2.85%. Local Government Permits and Fees vary, but do not exceed 2.5%.
- 8. Baseline Quantity: A minimum allowance for the base electric rate and is equal to 374 kWh per month for winter use and 551 kWh per month for summer use.
- 9. Seasonal Charges: The summer season is May 1 through October 31 and the winter season is November 1 through April 30. Bills that include May 1 and November 1 seasonal changeover dates will be calculated by prorating the applicable baseline quantity for each season by the number of days in each season for the billing period.
