



## PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING CORONAVIRUS

In accordance with federal and state health and safety guidance, MID is continuing to take temporary steps to reduce the potential spread of coronavirus. Although MID is taking advantage of the weather to temporarily pause deliveries and conserve water in Lake McClure, all water and electric operations continue. MID is monitoring weather conditions and growers needs: deliveries will resume as growers' needs dictate.

- The MID Main Administration office will remain staffed but closed. For the remainder of the week, water orders will not be taken during the pause in delivery but will soon resume as growers needs dictate.
