- **Water deliveries to resume after series of rainstorms**
- **District takes action to protect employees and community**

Merced Irrigation District will resume taking water orders on Thursday, March 26. Deliveries to growers will be made as the irrigation system fills and based on growers' demand.

Water deliveries were paused earlier in the week based on the rain and weather conditions. The break allowed the District to conserve water in Lake McClure. It also allowed MID to coordinate activity to reduce the potential transmission of coronavirus.

- MID has taken numerous steps to protect its employees and the public, in accordance with federal and state health and safety expert guidance. This includes temporarily closing the front office and taking proactive steps to disburse and distance employees.

This includes **fishing, recreational boating, houseboating and mountain biking**.
